- FAA airport designator: MRY
- Owned & operated by the Monterey Peninsula Airport District
- Located 4 miles west of downtown Monterey on the Monterey-Salinas Highway (Highway 68) at Olmstead Road
- Founded in 1936; organized as a Special District in 1941
- 498 acres
- Two parallel runways:
 - 10R/28L is 7,000 ft -Category I ILS Precision Approach to RW 10R
 - 10L/28R is 3,800 ft -General Aviation runway
- Number of Based Aircraft:
 - Single Engine = 126
 - Twin Engine= 21
 - Jets= 9
- 211 hangars and tie downs; 55 business tenants.
- Passengers flown in 2008: 427,542.
