The Monterey Peninsula Airport District will be having a public meeting, per section 158.23 of Part 158 Federal Aviation Regulations, of the intent of the Monterey Peninsula Airport District to hold consultation with all air carriers serving the Monterey Peninsula Airport and the General Public concerning the imposition and expenditure of a \$4.50 Passenger Facility Charge.

The projects being considered for funding with Passenger Facility Charge Revenue are:

PROJECT DESCRIPTION	PFC FUNDING
Airport Access and Road Safety and Security Construction	\$ 300,000.00
RSA Design Phase 2	\$ 75,000.00
RSA Construction Phase 1	\$ 600,000.00
Total	\$ 975,000.00

The level of charge proposed is \$4.50, with a proposed effective date of 08/01/2010 and an estimated expiration date of 08/01/2011. It is estimated that the total Passenger Facility Charge Revenues collected under this authority during that period will equal \$975,000.00.

The Airport will request to exempt unscheduled, intermittent Part 135 Air Taxis. The intermittent air taxi operators known to operate at the Airport and their 2007 reported enplanements, as listed in the most recent ACAIS Database Report of 2007, are as follows:

Compared to the total enplanements of 207,964 for the same period, the proposed exempted class represents approximately .0024% of annual enplanements, well below the Part 158 criterion of 1%.

The Airport's request for this exemption is based on the fact that related administrative costs for the Airport in attempting to track these unscheduled/intermittent activities would far exceed the potential annual PFC revenues of \$2,327.00 from these operators.
